Dr. Glenda Eoyang works with public and private organizations to help them thrive in the face of overwhelming complexity and uncertainty. She is a pioneer in the field of human systems dynamics (HSD), which she founded. As executive director of the HSD Institute, Glenda uses her models and methods to help others see patterns in the chaos that surrounds them, understand the patterns in simple

and powerful ways, and take practical steps to shift chaos into order.

Glenda's newest book, with co-author Royce Holladay, is *Adaptive Action: Leveraging Uncertainty in Your Organization* (Stanford University Press, 2013). She received her PhD in Human Systems Dynamics from Union Institute and University in 2001, and she is currently associated with Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario; The University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minnesota; and Temple University in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

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
