Camilo Azcarate has been the Manager of Mediation Services for the World Bank Group since 2008. Previously, he was the Ombudsman at Princeton University and taught Conflict Resolution at Columbia University's ICCCR.

In the late 1990's Camilo was an affiliate at the Program on International Conflict Analysis and Resolution (PICAR) at Harvard's Weatherhead Center, where he worked in projects to support peace efforts in Colombia, using Track II Diplomacy /Interactive Conflict Resolution.

Camilo is currently engaged with colleagues from Columbia's Earth Institute/ AC4 to promote the use of Dynamic System Theory within the World Bank and in its operations.

Camilo has a Juris Doctor from Universidad Javeriana, and LLM in Corporate Law and an MA in Dispute Resolution from the University of Massachusetts. He has been working in dispute resolution since 1993 as mediator, facilitator, coach, conflict system designer and Ombudsman in the international, environmental and workplace fields.
