Dr. S. Tjip Walker is a Senior Policy Advisor in the Bureau for Policy, Planning and Learning (PPL) at the US Agency for International Development (USAID). Currently he is leading Agency efforts to implement the [Local Systems Framework](#), USAID's commitment to sustained development that puts local systems at the center of its work. In support of that effort, Dr. Walker works across USAID to identify promising practices, develop tools, and spread system thinking.
