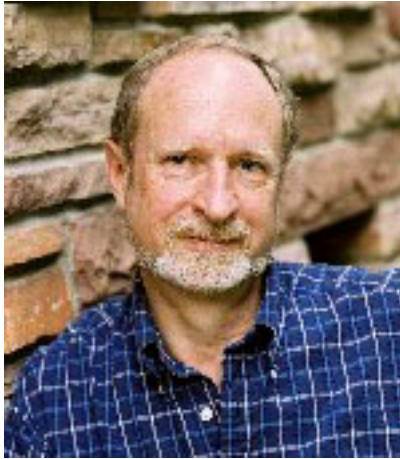


## Dynamical Systems Innovation Lab, July 8-12, 2013
